## **5. Finance Update**

£3923.65 in account.

This is after £4000 was spent purchasing 16 New IPADs for the school and waterproof jackets and trousers were purchased for nursery and reception.

Action: Julia to pull letter together listing events FOMs organised /supported in 2018, what was raised and what the money has been used for.

2018 events included Valentines Disco, Bingo Night, Easter Egg Raffle, Summer Raffle, Halloween Disco, Christmas Fair and Raffle. FOMs sold refreshments at Summer and Christmas Performances. FOMs also raised money in 2018 through Your School Lottery, Supporting Firefighters Charity through Recycling unwanted clothing and Class Fundraising selling Christmas Cards designed by the pupils.

Amount £4519.34 during 2018.

Letter, once wording agreed to be given to local businesses who supported the school and also to parents /carers via school bags.

Action:It was agreed that FOMs would fund a visit from a Chinese Dance Group to celebrate Chinese New Year on February 5<sup>th</sup> 2019.This will incorporate the dragon and other traditional

Chinese customs. Key Stage 2 children will take part in workshops to produce their own dance. This will cost around £400.

Action: Information board to be put together with posters showing what FOMs have raised via fundraising and what we have spent the funding on. Also need to add relevant School Lottery Posters and details of funding lottery raises. This will be done when school building work is complete and notice board is put up.
