School Funding

Today we sent out a separate letter 'School Funding Crisis and Petition', which has been circulated by the National Association of Head Teachers, highlighting the school funding issues that are affecting many schools around the North East and country as a whole. Whilst we are fortunate to be a growing school and can manage our budget accordingly, I believe funding shortfalls will have a negative impact on education and schools in Durham. The Governors and I fully support the idea of raising awareness of the issue and if this continued longer term, all schools would be affected. The figures quoted on the letter are alarming and if you feel that you would like this to be discussed in parliament please follow the instructions on the letter. Thank you.

If you would like more tickets please let the School Office know and we will check if it is possible to fulfil the request.

Christmas Carol Service December 14th at 2pm

Tickets are not required for the Carol Service at St Mary's and we that hope many of you can join us there in your Christmas jumpers! Last year many of you were able to attend and most decided to collect their child from St Mary's at the end of the concert. To make these arrangements as easy as possible, we are encouraging children not to bring a school bag on this day and they will only need their packed lunch box with them (if they have packed lunch). Please make sure that your child has a warm coat, hat etc. for the journey. We will be walking down to church and aim to get to there for 1.45pm but will need a little time to get organised, so will look to start at 2pm.

Any children who are not being collected at church will be walked back up to school by staff.
