GRANT BID

Based on things raised at parents' evening I feel there is a need for a dedicated counsellor to help both pupils and parents. I have completed a grant application through Northern Housing to fund such a counsellor. If the bid is successful a male counsellor will work in our school half a day per week from January until the Summer. I believe a male offering emotional wellbeing, counselling, and support to parents or families and to act as a positive role model will help many of our youngsters and indeed yourselves.

FIRE SAFETY

We were able to use our new fire alarm for our half termly fire evacuation drill this week. All children heard the alarm —a big plus over our previous archaic system & responded effectively. The tests are held at different times through the school day so children are prepared for a range of occasions when evacuation may be necessary. They are taught to leave personal belongings behind and go out immediately. On this occasion children went out wearing indoor shoes due to the timing of the drill. Children were then told on their return to change into p.e. shoes if their shoes were wet. We encourage children to change their footwear to keep carpet and floor areas clean so that in Reception & Key Stage 1 classes children can take part in floor based activities e.g. building & model making. An old pair of slippers, trainers or p.e. shoes is fine for indoors.

To coincide with the fire drill Nursery & Reception pupils (i.e. EALY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE) were able to explore the Fire Engine and ask questions of the Fire & Rescue personnel who visited school on Thursday. The youngsters enjoyed operating the hoses and finding out how to be safe.

HAVE YOU GOT WORKING SMOKE ALARMS & HAVE YOU A FIRE EVACUATION PLAN AT HOME? It is worthwhile discussing as a family what you would do in the event of a fire.
