Now we are into winter I wish to remind you of inclement weather procedures.

Children will be invited into school before 9 am when it is wet, slippery or snowing. At break times we go out in most weathers unless it is too wet or slippery. So please make sure your child has suitable clothing & footwear.

Our rule regarding snowballing is children wishing to partake in this activity may do so on the grassed area, whilst those not wishing to be involved stay on the tarmac area.

We aim in most circumstances to open and remain open throughout the day for the purpose of educating your children. Decisions to close are not taken lightly and are the result of assessing the risk to pupils, parents and staff.

On snowy mornings tune into **RADIO TEESDALE** as they will be informed if we are not opening. If our school is not mentioned on there then we are open. You can also visit our school website where a rolling banner will let you know if we are closed.

If school is open BUT you feel it is unsafe for your child to access the school bus or for you to drive and you are not able to walk to school it is important that you ring to advise us of your child's absence.
