

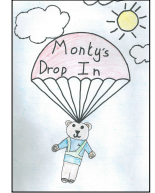

**Academic Years 2013-2014** – There have been significant changes to the school’s leadership team of late; with a new headteacher, deputy headteacher and English leader joining school in September 2014. Consequently, it is difficult to account for 2013-2014 spending, but scrutiny of historical performance data shows no significant gaps in attainment between FSM and Non-FSM children. This suggests good use was made of Pupil Premium money last year. (We have highlighted attainment of More Able as one possible area to improve.)

The current Pupil Premium allocation for Montalbo is £32500 for 2014-2015.

As a result of last year’s data, some of this year’s pupil premium allocation will be used to target children to achieve level 5s in Reading, Writing and Maths.

- Targeted intervention groups to improve attainment in identified areas such as Reading, Writing or Mathematics to help children achieve level 5 by the end of KS2 (£15000).
- Time with Emotional Health and Wellbeing Worker where applicable on identified need such as self esteem (£3750)
- 1:1 Teacher Assistant time to help enable the very few underperforming FSM children to make outstanding progress. (£9750)
- Curriculum resources, including Hornets, Toe by Toe and Accelerated reader (£2500).
- Dedicated weekly time with teacher to raise attainment in identified areas (£1000).
- After school booster and study aids for Y2 and Y6 in the Spring Term (£500).
