Christmas arrangements

As we approach December and the busy festive period, rehearsals and preparation for forthcoming events are gathering momentum! We are continuing with similar ideas for school performances, with Nursery and Reception performing a Nativity on December 17th at 2.00pm.

If you would like more tickets please let the School Office know and we will check if it is possible to fulfil the request.
