These stone forests were formed from limestone 270 million years ago. The rocks have been shaped by the wind and rain to create the unusual shapes and spikes.

These huge limestone stacks have been shaped by the action of the sea.

There are 40,000 columns in the Giants Causeway made of basalt. They were formed by volcanic activity.

This is a huge gap in the earth's crust. It is 1,300km long. It is caused by the movement of the tectonic plates.

Human mining activity changes the shape of the land by moving rock and rock and huge amounts of water.
