Monday	easy letters c, o	<p>Science</p> <p>Odd one out (see Odd one out worksheet). Ask your child to identify the odd one out from the 3 pictures? Explore different possible answers.</p> <p>Play 'What are you?' – Write an animal down on a piece of paper, without your child seeing. They should ask questions to identify which animal you are. Eg. Do you lay eggs? Do you have wings? What colour are you?
