This fantastic Blitz artwork was created by painting a red a red/orange background. This artist then cut out silhouettes from black paper or card.

You could shade the background in pencil and use newspaper for the buildings for a black and white effect. Some of Banksy's artwork has been sold for hundreds of thousands of dollars in the USA.

You could re-create your very own Banksy inspired piece of art – you just need a black pen and some paper...

Don't draw on the walls!

In this perspective drawing, the soldiers appear to march into the distance. They get smaller to make the men look further away. You could have a go at drawing your own perspective artwork.

You could cut up old magazines and newspapers for a coloured background if you don't have paint or coloured paper.
