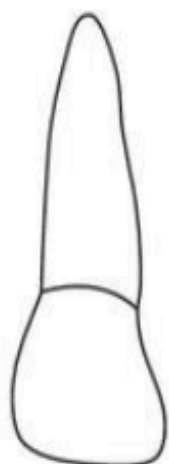

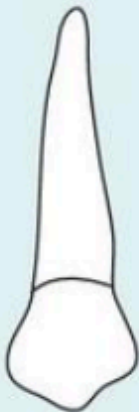
## Incisor

- Used to slice chunks of food.



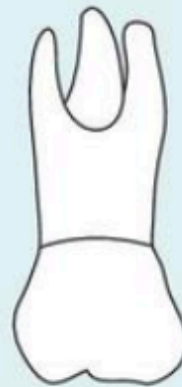
## Canine
