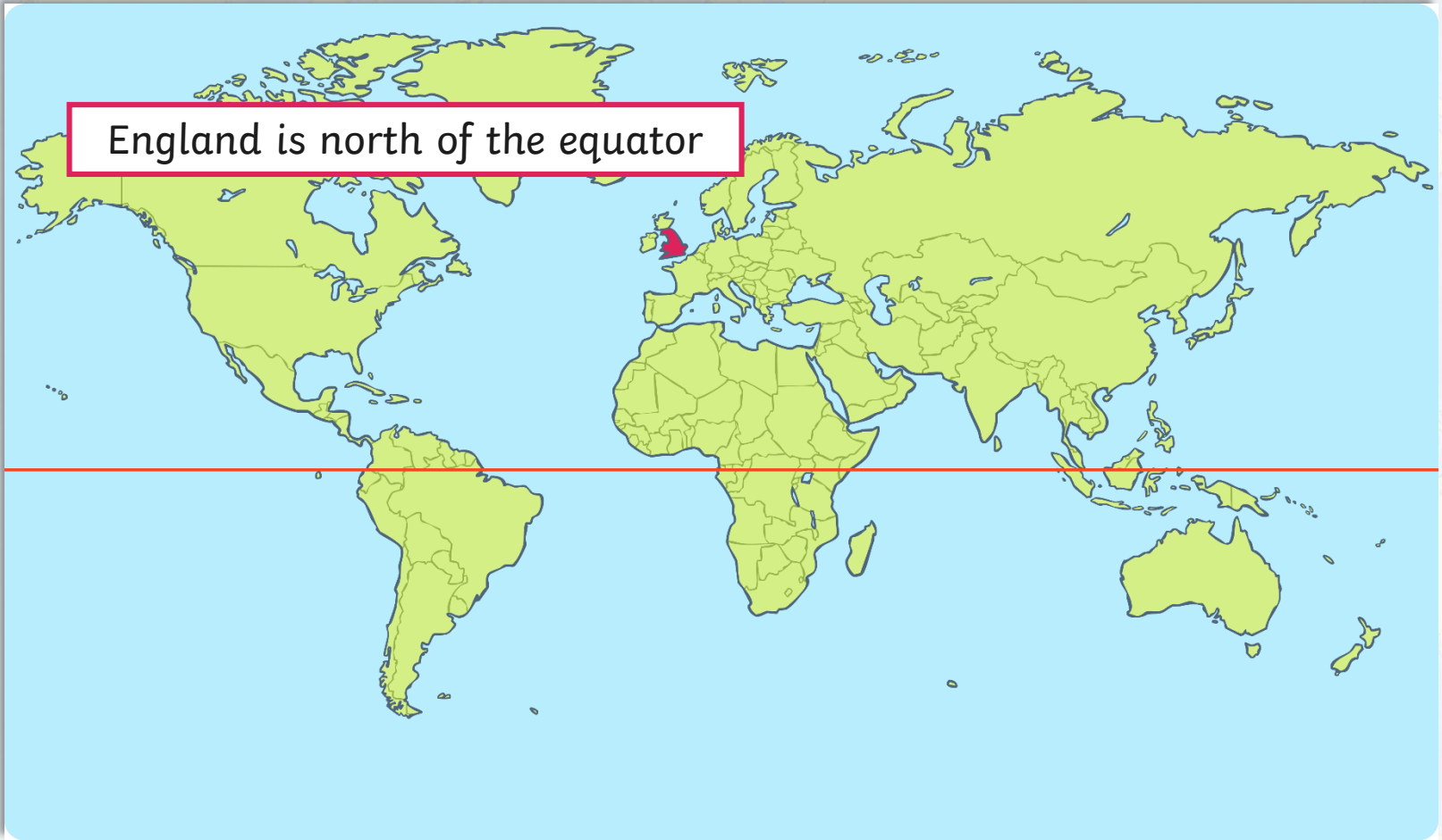
The Equator

The equator is an imaginary line around the centre of the Earth which is equal distance from the North and South Poles.

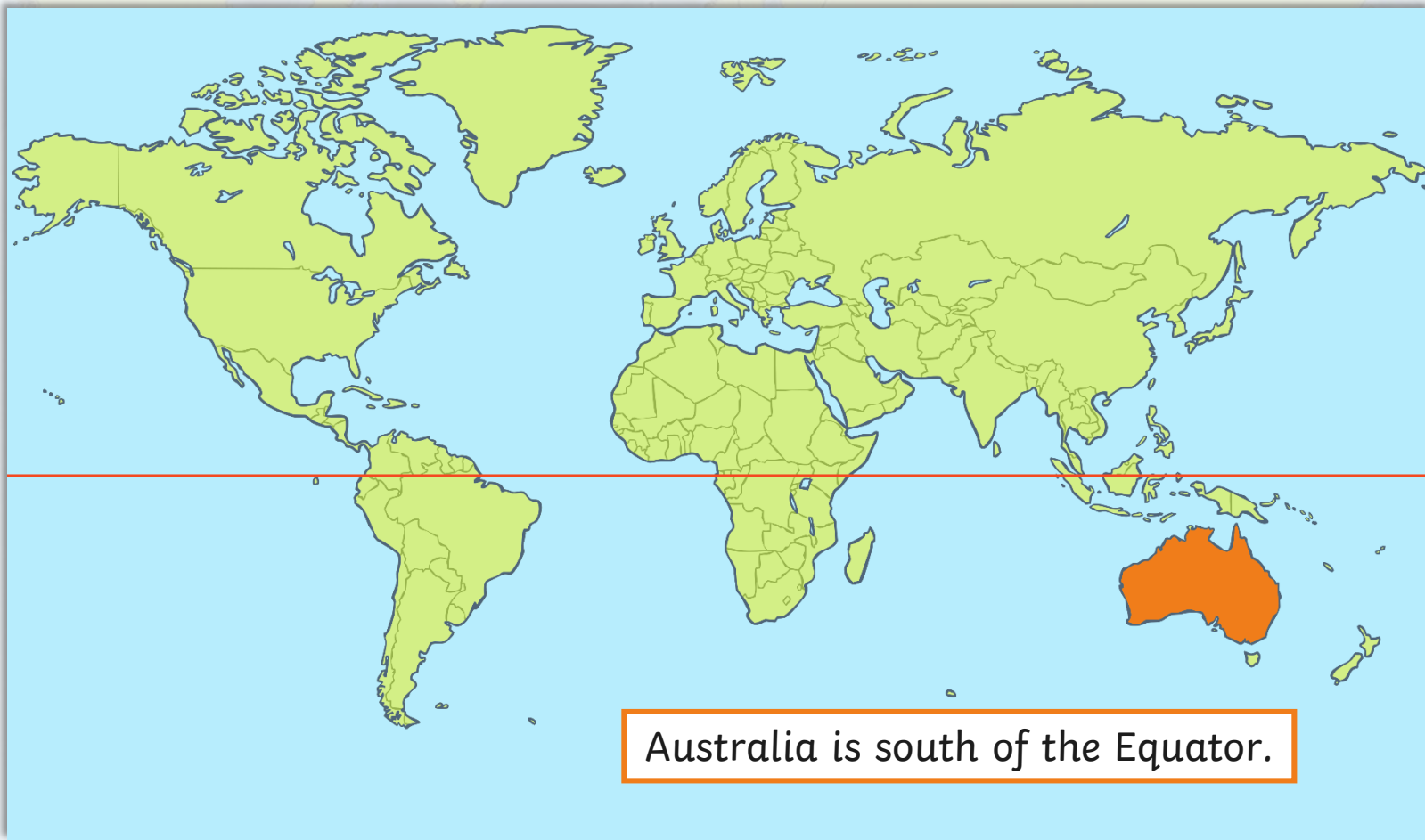


The Equator

England is north of the equator

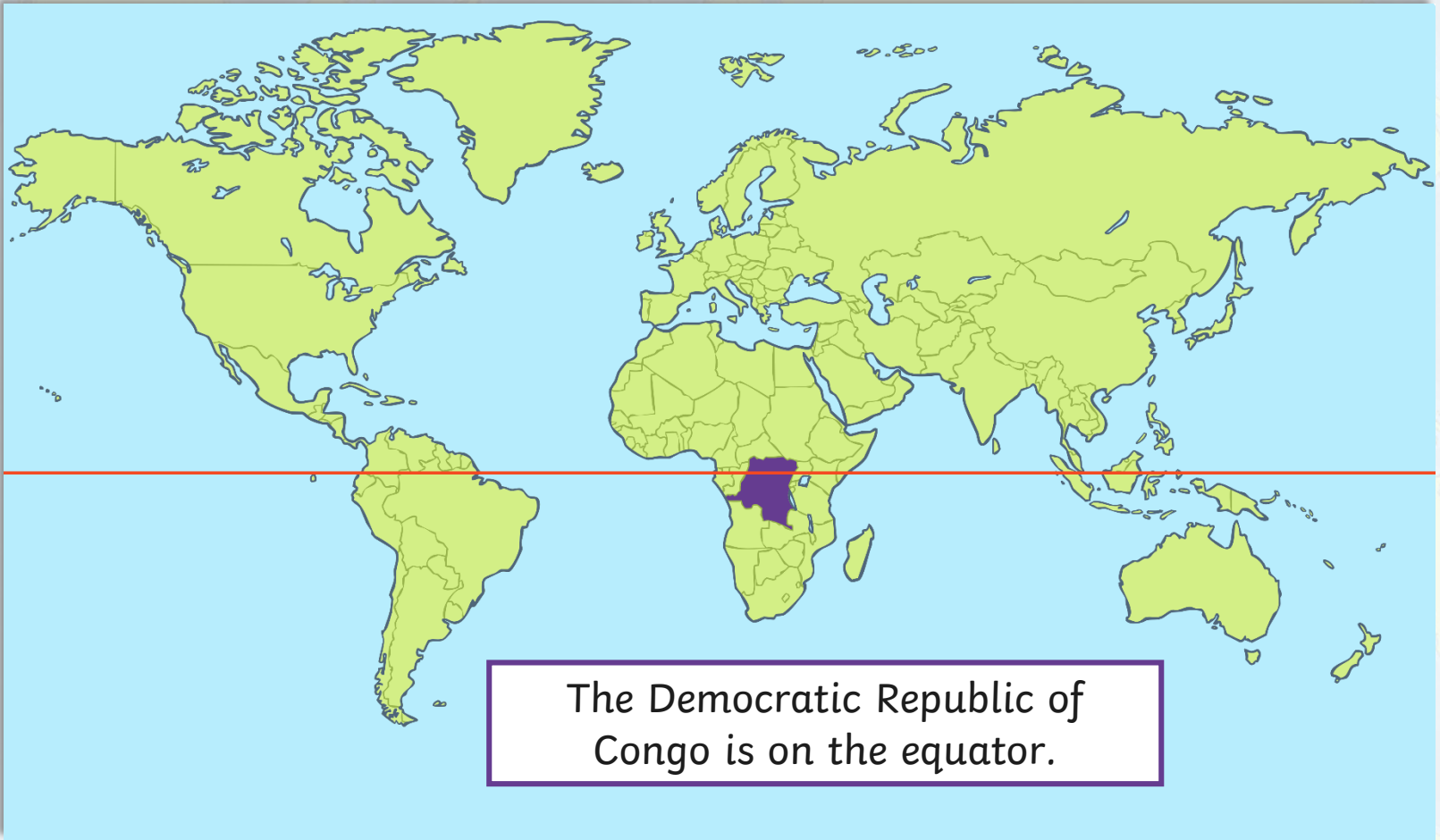


The Equator



Australia is south of the Equator.

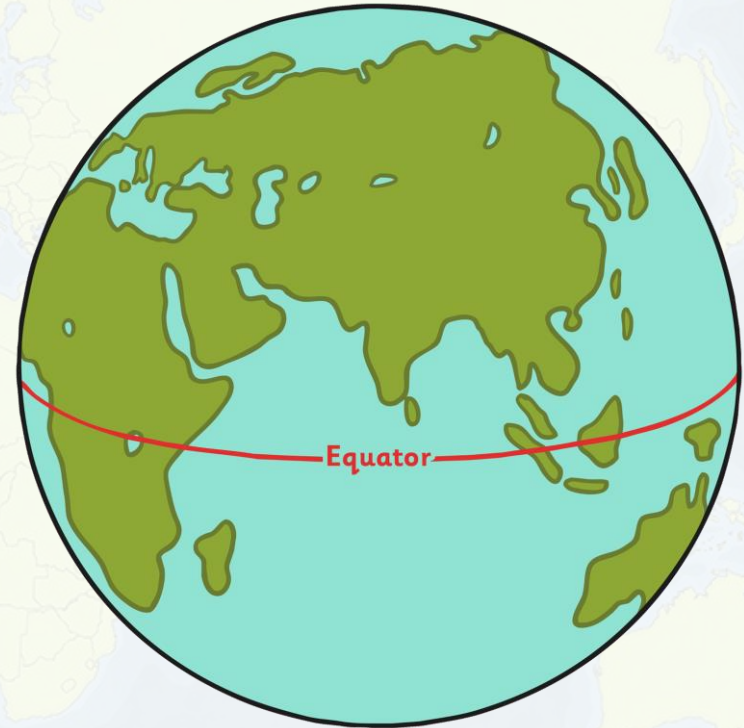

Equator

- The equator is an imaginary line that divides the Earth in half.
- The equator is an equal distance between the North and South Poles.
- The weather on the equator is hot all year round.
- At the equator, day and night are both 12 hours long.
