Reception School Places September 2022

The window for applying for Reception places opened on Monday and runs until January 15th 2022. If you would like to visit school, please contact the School Office who will arrange this with you. Parent/Carers of all children eligible to start Reception must submit an application. Further details on the process can be found here.

Covid 19

It is really important that parents/carers do not send their child to school with any of the following symptoms. If you have COVID-19, you should not be bringing your child to school yourself and should arrange for others to bring and collect your child.

Please take a cautious approach at this time: -

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

The basic principles are if your child has COVID 19 or any of the COVID 19 symptoms they should not be attending school. A link for ordering PCR tests is here or you can also telephone 119. It is advisable to have the test as quickly as possible and report the outcome to school as soon as possible.

The guidance around close contacts and households has changed as have the rules around self-isolation. The link is <u>here</u> but it is advisable to contact the school as each case may be slightly different. Thank you.

How do I give my consent?

- 1. Go to https://www.hdft.nhs.uk/fluconsent/
- 2. Enter the School Code 114115 and click "Find School".
- 3. Complete the form with your child's information and parent/guardian contact information*.
- 4. Click the green "Submit" button.
