Great Teaching and Learning

This week has been very busy but rewarding. I have had the pleasure of visiting most classes to see children at work in a range of curriculum subjects. I was delighted with the children's learning behaviours, work ethic and confidence: they demonstrated our key values - to endeavour, to collaborate and to be inspired. Children were using high order vocabulary and are very knowledgeable about their topics. Our strengths in reading were evident with the fast-paced, systematic phonics programme allowing children to make pleasing progress. Well done to all of children and staff.

Year 6 Visit to Eden Camp

The Year 6s enjoyed a brilliant day at Eden Camp. They visited 29 huts which contained various displays and artefacts from World War II. There was also an entertaining puppet show involving World War II songs in the Music Hall! The children particularly enjoyed seeing the Spitfires too. Dr Greenwell commented on the excellent behaviour of Year 6 which is always great to hear.

Year 5 Visit to the Bowes Museum and the Locomotion

Today our Year 5 children are visiting the Bowes Museum and Locomotion to learn about automation. You may have seen on the local news that the iconic Silver Swan is being restored and children will learn more about how things work in preparation for their Design and Technology topic. I look forward to finding out more on their return.

Visits and Sporting Festivals next week

On Monday the Year 2 children will visit the Bowes Museum for the culmination of their work on the John and Josephine Bowes story, which they have been learning about in History. They will also learn more about one of the travelling curiosities, Clara the Rhino!

On Tuesday, Year 5 visit Captain Cook's Birthplace Museum to aid their understanding of his life and explorations. I visited the class for a History lesson this week where the children were learning differing views on Captain James Cook's life and it was really pleasing to see them questioning and debating so maturely.

On Wednesday, Year 4 take part in a tag rugby festival at Staindrop Academy after learning more about the sport with an external coach in PE this half term.

On Thursday, Year 5 are attending a Multi-Skills festival at Staindrop Academy. Good luck to all of the children attending sports next week.
