Eco Smart Conference

In November 2021, the UK will host COP26 in Glasgow. COP26 will be the 26th United Nations Climate Change Conference with 197 countries involved. Over 4000 pupils from 130 schools in 13 countries are taking part in the ECO2 Smart Schools Climate Conference to learn about COP and how other schools from around the world are experiencing and adapting to climate change. Next Thursday, Montalbo has the opportunity to represent our country at the ECO2 Smart Schools Virtual Climate Conference. During the event, the Years 3 to 6 will be challenged to think about the issue of climate change and explore each other's experiences of it. As part of this project we have been twinned with schools in France and the USA, allowing the children an opportunity to understand how climate issues vary around the world. These classes have completed lessons that have helped them to reflect on what we can do as a school and community to help our world.

Reception School Places September 2022

The window for applying for Reception places has opened and runs until January 15th 2022. If you would like to visit school, please contact the School Office who will arrange this with you. Covid 19

It is really important that parents/carers do not send their child to school with any of the following symptoms. If you have COVID-19, you should not be bringing your child to school yourself and should arrange for others to bring and collect your child.

Please take a cautious approach at this time: -

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

The basic principles are if your child has COVID 19 or any of the COVID 19 symptoms they should not be attending school. A link for ordering PCR tests is here or you can also telephone 119. It is advisable to have the test as quickly as possible and report the outcome to school as soon as possible.

School Meals Menu

If any child currently on packed lunches wishes to have a school meal please contact the office for a menu, alternatively, if your child no longer wishes to have a school meal 2 weeks' notice is required by the school meals provider. If you have had a change in circumstances and believe you may be eligible for Free School Meals please contact the school office for an application form. This applies to all pupils including those in Reception, Year 1 & 2 who are in receipt of Universal Free School meals.
