

Last Year's Results

October 20th 2023

This week end of 2023 data was released and it makes pretty impressive reading. Our figures were 'significantly above national' in many areas and 'above' in every statutory assessment from Reception to Year 6. For example, in Key Stage 1 Writing and Maths at the expected standard, we were in the top 7% and 4% of all primary schools. In Key Stage 2 Reading, Writing and Maths combined - the top 3%; Grammar Punctuation and Spelling - the top 4%; Reading Higher Scores - the top 1%. Well done TeamMonty!

This week several children from Key Stage 2 attended a Cross Country Event at Staindrop. They all performed really well and special congratulations must go to Ruby from Year 4 who won the race in her age range. Well done to everyone who took part!
