# Teesdale Cancer Research Pink Day and Run

We have been contacted by the fabulous group at Teesdale Cancer Research. They will be holding their Turn Barney Pink in October and we are keen to support their work. On October 15<sup>th</sup> we will encourage children and staff to come in pink or have some pink on their clothes and take part in a run to support the charity.

#### Tax-Free Childcare

At a meeting I attended this week, one of the advisers at the Local Authority discussed Tax-Free childcare and asked us to make sure parents/carers are aware of this system. I know many of our families do use this but if you do not, please see below:

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).

If you get Tax-Free Childcare, you'll set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2, to use to pay your provider.

### What you can use Tax-Free Childcare for

You can use it to pay for approved childcare, for example:

- · childminders, nurseries and nannies
- · after school clubs and play schemes
