I have really enjoyed this half term and have been very impressed with all of our children over what is one of the longer half terms of the school calendar. They have settled into their new classes brilliantly and it has been great to see the standard of work the children are producing, learning behaviours and the enthusiasm within each class. I try to spend a little time in each class each day or more formally, such as the last few weeks when we look at our provision in more detail. This year we are having an increased focus on handwriting and writing in general as well as mental Maths and these are showing promising signs of improving outcomes for children. I have taken in samples of reading records and the vast majority of children read regularly at home and this is making a huge difference to their language development, imagination and love of books, which in turn helps with assessments throughout their time in education.

Away from the core subjects, it has been a rich curriculum in terms of History and Geography, where there have been many educational visits to add to children's knowledge and understanding. We have enjoyed some fun and success in sports and learnt some amazing facts about different faiths in RE. In Computing we have covered important online safety topics which continues to be so important in modern life.

Next half term sees us switch from Humanities to Arts, which I know our children enjoy very much. There is so much to look forward to with the Dance Off and all of the wonderful Christmas activities.

Our new staff have already become valued members of Team Monty and I thank our whole team for their superb work this half term. Have a great holiday and we look forward to seeing our children on Monday November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
